## Chapter 7

### Green Eggs and Ham - Styling

#### Create a web page with the following parameters:

1. Include the text of Green Eggs and Ham below. (Hint: Copy and paste the entire text from this file or the included text file "greeneggs.txt.")
2. Include the title "Green Eggs and Ham" as a heading.
3. Add tags <p> and <br> where needed so that the formatting matches what is below.

#### Here's an example:

<p>I do not like green eggs and ham! </p>
```

<p>I do not like them, <br>  
Sam-I-am. </p>

4. The name of the HTML file should be greeneggs.html.
5. Include the image green-eggs-and-ham.png at the very top of the page. In order to do this, you must start with the image green-eggs-and-ham.xcf image and do the following:
  - Make the background transparent:
    - Open the image in Gimp
    - Change the foreground color to a color not in the image, like 4411ff (blue).
    - Using the bucket tool, color the background blue as well as the 2 small areas in the fork.
    - Select the blue area using the fuzzy wand tool. After you do that, you will need to hold down the Shift key and then click on those 2 small areas of the fork to add them to the selection.
    - Grow the selection by 1 pixel.
    - Cut the background out by choosing Edit>Cut.
    - Choose Select>None.
  - Rescale the image to 300 by 475 pixels at resolution 96 ppi.
  - Export the image as green-eggs-and-ham.png.

6. Create an external CSS file named greeneggs.css.
7. Your web page must have the following styles:
  - The background color of the page should be #e0faff.
  - The margin of the body should be 10%.
  - Make a border of 5px LightSkyBlue around the body.
  - The padding of the body should be 50px.
  - The heading should be green.
  - All of the text spoken by Sam I Am should be blue.
  - All of the text spoken by the other guy should also be green.
