## Chapter 4

### Focus on Structure – Using What You Know

**For this assignment you must create a website with the following parameters:**

#### **Parameters for Content:**

- The topic is your choice. Suggestions might be animal, person, plant, place, food, hobby, etc.

#### **Parameters for File Structure:**

- A root folder (your choice of name)
- An HTML file named “index.html” inside your root folder
- An images folder (if you use any images)
- At least one folder below the root folder

#### **Parameters for Elements:**

Your web pages must include at least one of the each of the following:

- A list (unordered, ordered, or definition)
- Two levels of headings
- Paragraphs
- Line Breaks
- Hyperlinks:
  - At least one relative link
  - At least one absolute link to a page on the Internet
- A link into a specific spot in your webpage using the `id` attribute
- A quote or a blockquote

#### **Parameters for Style:**

- Use the HTML color picker at [http://www.w3schools.com/tags/ref\\_colorpicker.asp](http://www.w3schools.com/tags/ref_colorpicker.asp) to choose a background color for your web pages. Add this to your style element.
- Your web pages may include any of the the other style elements that we have learned so far.

#### **Final notes:**

- You are not required to use any images but feel free to include them if you’d like.
  - To use online photos, right-click on the image and choose “Save As.” Remember what I said about using copyrighted images for published websites. Since this website is *not* being published online, you can use any image you find online.
- You will be adding style and images to this website later, so don’t worry about adding a lot of styling elements right now. Focus on STRUCTURE!
