Chapter 5 Adding Images to Your Site

For this assignment you will be using the web pages that you turned in week 5. This is your original work on the topic of your choice. Now that you know more about images, you need to do the following:

- 1. Clean up images that you already have on your page (if necessary) now that you know how to do that in Gimp.
- 2. Add the back arrow that you made using Gimp from the last assignment to each of your pages.
- 3. Make either a logo for your pages or make a fancy text image for your main heading instead of using <h1>. Whichever you use, it should be made in Gimp.
- 4. Have at least one image on each page (other than the back arrow and logo/heading).
 - One of these needs to be original. It can be a graphic design or it can be a
 photo that you took. If it is a photo, make sure to scale the image to
 between 72 and 96 ppi using Gimp.
 - One of these must have a transparent background. It should be an image that you edited using Gimp to make the background transparent.

<u>Optional</u>: If you have quite a few images on your page that are large, consider making thumbnail images and link them to their own pages.
