Chapter 8

The Wonderful Thing About Tiggers - Styling

Create a web page with the following parameters:

1. The name of the HTML file should be tigger.html.
2. Include the text of *The Wonderful Thing About Tiggers* below. (Hint: Copy and paste the entire text from this file or the included text file "tigger.txt.")
3. Include the title "The Wonderful Thing About Tiggers" as a heading.
4. Find a picture of Tigger online and include it on your page. If the background does not match your background, you will either need to make the image transparent or use the bucket tool to fill your current background with the same color you are using for your background.
5. Add tags <p> and
 where needed so that the formatting matches what is below.
6. Create an external CSS file named tigger.css. All CSS should be written in this file and linked from the HTML file.
7. Your web page must have the following styles:
 - The background of your page can be anything but white.
 - Set a reasonable margin amount for the body.
 - Create a border if you'd like, but it's optional.
 - Use whatever fonts you'd like, but have a generic font-family listed as well.
 - Set the default font size of the body to "medium."
 - Use a percent to set the size of the Poem's title to be twice the size of the text of the body.
 - Assign a class to each of the poem's verses below (there are 6) and style each one differently using fonts, styles, sizes, weights, colors, and text-decorations.
 - In your styling, use colors by name, RGB, or hex. (See http://www.w3schools.com/html/html_colornames.asp for examples)
