Chapter 9

The Box Model

For this assignment you are going to be styling paragraphs using various borders, margins, and padding, and the borders must use various styles, widths, colors, sides, and corners.

Here are the specifics:

1. Create an HTML file named "quotes.html" and put it in a folder named "quotes."
2. Create a CSS file named "quotes.css" and put it in the folder named "quotes." Link to it from your HTML file. All styling must be done in the css file.
3. The title of your HTML file is to be "Quotes."
4. Make sure to include the doctype and <meta> tag that are standard for HTML 5
5. Begin your HTML page with an <h1> heading that reads "Favorite Quotes."
6. Choose 8 quotes from <http://www.goodreads.com/quotes> or find other quotes that you like.
7. Each quote should be included in <p> tags like this example:

```
<p id="seuss"> "Don't cry because it's over, smile because it happened." <br>  
— Dr. Seuss </p>
```

8. Each paragraph must be assigned to a different id name.
9. Each quote should appear in a paragraph that uses a different combination of styles. Be creative! Your grade on this assignment will partly be based on the variety of combinations you come up with. Have fun with it! Experiment!
10. You may use different background colors for the paragraphs if you'd like, but not background images.
11. The background color of your page should be white (the default color).
12. See pp. 370-371 for examples of the box model, and also pp. 386-88 for more styles for your borders.
